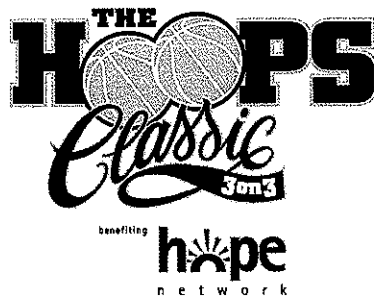

Details:

- The number of teams is limited, so don't be left on the sidelines. Entries are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. **Registration must be postmarked no later than May 24, 2008.**
- Teams may register 3 or 4 players.
- Age on game day determines division of play. Minimum age is 8. Proof of age is required.
- Each player must complete a waiver of liability form. Signature of parent or guardian is required if under age 18. No one will be permitted to play without a signed waiver.
- Any mixed gender team will be required to play in the Boys' or Men's Division.
- As a general rule, high school and college players are eligible to participate. For specific eligibility information, contact your basketball coach or athletic director.
- Rosters are frozen after entry. Substitution in event of illness or injury prior to the start of tournament will be permitted for a \$10 fee.
- **A nonrefundable entry fee must accompany completed entry form. Entry fees: \$100 per team if postmarked before April 30, 2008; \$140 per team if postmarked before May 24, 2008; \$400 per Corporate team.**
- Games will be played rain or shine, but may be cancelled in the event of heavy rain, wind, or lightning. Tournament organizers reserve the right to limit or curtail the schedule if weather requires.

Rules:

1. Games are played to 16 points by one-point baskets (win by one) or a 25-minute time limit.
2. A two-point shot line will be in effect.
3. The ball will change hands after each score.
4. Play will start from beyond the two-point shot line after a score.
5. The ball must be taken beyond the two-point shot line with any change of possession.
6. Substitution is permitted after a score.
7. Referees will officiate most games. In the event that a referee is not available, then players will call their own fouls. Courtside monitors will settle any disputes, and their decisions will be final.
8. Free throws will be shots on shooting fouls.
9. One 1-minute timeout per team will be permitted; timeouts will stop the 25-minute game clock.
10. A protest committee will hear disputes after the contested game subject to a \$10 protest fee (refundable if won). The committee will then be the final authority on these matters.
11. Flagrant fouls, hanging on the rim, misconduct, rough play, abusive language, or use of unregistered players may result in the forfeiture and dismissal from the tournament.

ATTENTION

Every reasonable effort will be made to ensure the safety of the participants, but neither HOPE Network, Galleria at Pittsburgh Mills, their boards of directors, sponsors, or affiliated persons assume responsibility for injuries or lost/stolen property. By signing the entry form, the participant and his/her parent/guardian (if applicable) agree to release and hold harmless all parties associated with the event from injury, damage, or loss from claims or course of action whatsoever. Furthermore, the participant, by his/her signature grants permission to use any photography, video recordings, or other record of the event. Your signature verifies that the participant or parent/guardian has read and fully understands the aforementioned and certifies that the information provided in this entry is true.
